Contracts will start when your signed contract and first payment is received, all contracts will end on April 30th, 2027, and you will be enrolled in our automatic delivery plan. Plans with an installment option, payments can be broken into monthly payments from the signing of contract through April 30th, 2027. Payments will be processed on the 15th of every month.

Pre-buy Option 1 \$ 5.499 per gallon (BEST VALUE) *

Full payment is due with signed contract, and the price per gallon will be billed at the fixed price until April 30th, 2027, after price per gallon will be billed at the daily cash price.

Pre-buy Option 2 \$ 5.749 per gallon *

1/3 payment is due with signed contract, and the price per gallon will be billed at the fixed price until April 30th, 2026. Remaining balance payments can be broken into monthly payments from the signing of contract through April 30th, 2027.

Budget Fixed Price Plan \$ 5.999 per gallon *

The first payment is due with a signed contract, and the price per gallon will be billed at the listed fixed price. Remaining balance payments can be broken into monthly payments from the signing of contract through April 30th, 2027.

Budget Plan \$ 5.999 per gallon *

The first payment is due with a signed contract, the price per gallon will be billed at the listed daily cash price. Remaining balance payments can be broken into monthly payments from the signing of contract through April 30th, 2027.
